The objective is to provide an environment in which you can learn primarily by doing, and in the process teach you my 3-step approach to painting and provide you with insights about improving your designs, drawing, values, color, edges, and surface quality. I will include demos, group feedback, and time for you to paint with individual help from me. It is my intention to provide as much time for you to paint as possible in this workshop. I feel that you will learn mostly by doing; therefore the more paintings you do the more you will learn. Small paintings go much quicker.” Betty Liles

Supply List:

- Drawing pad and pencil for notes and sketches
- Bristle brushes in at least 3 sizes (small, medium, large) Also bring whatever brushes you prefer.
- Paint or pallet knife (used for mixing as well as painting)
- Landscape photographs to paint from.
- Oil or Acrylics paints—whichever you prefer to use. Bring at least yellow, red, blue, and white. (Titanium White, Cadmium Yellow, Pyrrol Red, and Ultramarine Blue). Choose a bright yellow & bright red.
- Brush cleaner (Gamsol, odorless mineral spirits for oils) or water for Acrylics.
- Pallet for paints, paper towels, trash bags,
- Small canvases or canvas pad—8”x 10” or 9” x 12”

About the Instructor: Betty studied commercial and fine art at Austin Peay State University and did graduate work in studio painting at Murray State University. She has exhibited in many art shows throughout the region and won several awards for her paintings. Painting and drawing is a passion that she has enjoyed all her life. She is well versed in most medias.
